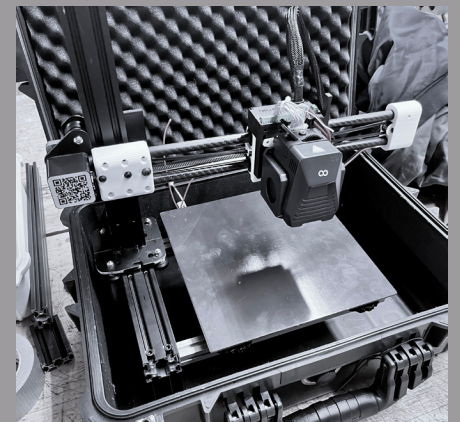
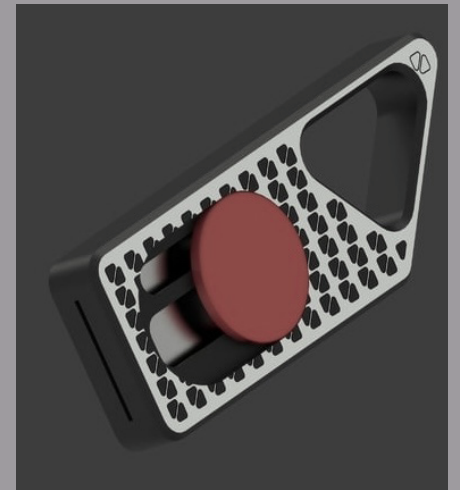
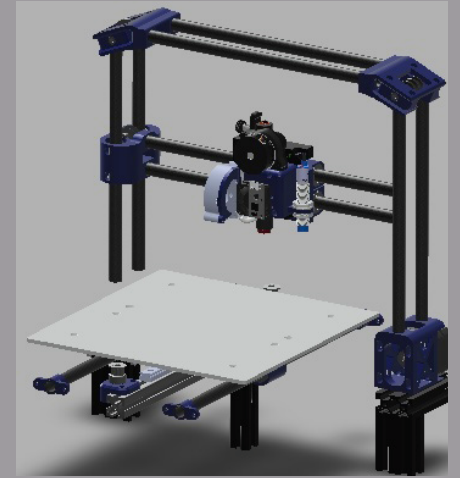
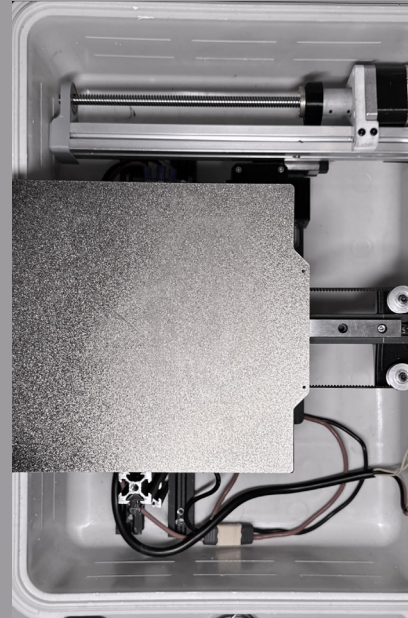
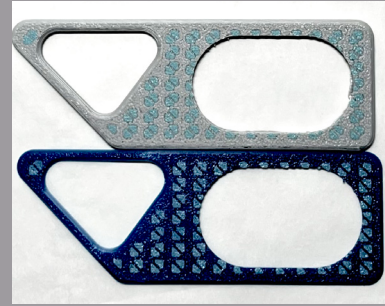


The quote reflects how he approaches making; move fast, figure it out, adjust later. Not everything has to be perfect before it begins.
